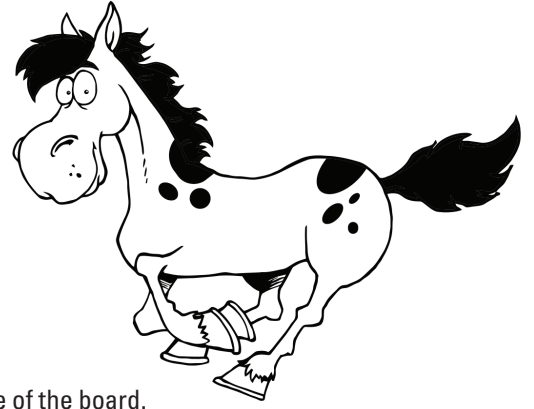


Domino Derby



Building Fluency: adding within 20

Materials: gameboard, set of dominoes, paper, pencil

Number of Players: 2

Directions:

1. Place dominoes face down on the table.
2. Players take turns drawing a domino.
3. Add the sum of the dots on the domino.
4. If it matches the player's side of the game board, the player places in on their side of the board.
If the sum equals six, the player loses their turn.
5. The first player to fill their side of the gameboard wins.

Variation/Extension: Each player should write a number sentence to explain why the domino does or does not fit (eg. $2 + 3 = 5$; $5 < 6$)

PLAYER 1: Less than six

PLAYER 2: More than six
