

# Presentation Guidelines Grade 5

Be sure to include the following information in your presentation

- **QUESTION**
  - What question did you ask?
  - Did it change?
  - Would you revise it? How?
  - What was your hypothesis?
  
- **DATA COLLECTION**
  - Describe how you collected your data.
  - Would you make changes in the way you collected data? Why? Why not?
  
- **ANALYSIS**
  - Share the minimum and maximum data points and the range.
  - Were there any unusual data points?
  - What did you learn from the shape of your data?
  - Share the median, mode and mean. What did you learn from these measures of center?
  - How did you choose to represent your data? Why? Which of your representations is better? Why?
  - Would you change any of your representations? Why? Why not?
  
- **INTERPRETATION**
  - Evaluate your your hypothesis.
  - Does your data answer your question?
  - What other possible questions come to mind?
  
- **REFLECTION**
  - What did you like best about your investigation?
  - What would you change to make it better?
